RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF S1798, "AN ACT TO ENHANCE THE LICENSE PLATE SYSTEM OF THE COMMONWEALTH."

Springfield, Massachusetts endorse this bill; and

WHEREAS: The bill also has the endorsement of the New England Association

of Chiefs of Police and the Massachusetts District Attorney

Association, as well as, the Criminal Justice Information System of

the FBI; and, Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council of the City of Worcester hereby supports

Senate Bill 1798 and urges our State Legislature to pass this bill as

expeditiously as possible.
