**re: EZ-ID/Molly's Bill S2299**

**(just changed from Senate Bill S1798)**

The tremendous progress on this critical public safety Bill, which has been voted forward favorably after 8 years in the Transportation Committee, is stuck once again and **we need your immediate help, as there is only 1 week left to this year's legislative session!** The Bill is in the Senate Ways and Means Committee (where we have shown them how it even makes money, and saves money for the State), but the Bill is collecting dust...because there are other Bills which are more important than saving children's lives, you should feel outraged! We cannot afford to hire high paid lobbyists to push this legislation through, we have to rely on each other to do so.

70% of all crime involves the usage of a motor vehicle, if you or someone close to you needs help, which license plate system do you want in place? Two weeks ago, there was an attempted abduction in Salem, and with the partial vehicle and plate information...it only narrowed the search down to **1 in 9,437 vehicles**, though if it was an EZ-ID plate...that same information would have narrowed the search down to **1 in 9 vehicles! EZ-ID is the 1-2 punch with the Amber Alert System, so let's keep our children safe!!!**

**Senate President, Therese Murray**, is a great legislator and she has been supportive, but **we need to ask her to get more involved...in motivating the Ways and Means Committee Chairman, Stephen Brewer, to make this a priority!** Chairman Brewer is a good man, and hopefully he will listen to you...to make EZ-ID a priority. **It is critical that you email them immediately, and please also call if you can during business hours. Please ask your friends and contacts to do so as well. If they get 200 phone calls and 1,000 emails...they cannot ignore us, will you be one of them???** PLEASE HELP, because if we do not do this for our children, who will?
